

You may be aware that this year sees the start of the exciting Church garden project and we are backing this 100% of the way! The All Saints' Welcome Garden Project is soon to become a reality (you can view the vision and plans

in the foyer in Church), with Phase 1 commencing early Spring. The overall project aims are:

- To create an outside space which is inviting and welcoming (the garden will replace the graveyard at the front of Church)
- To improve the appearance of the approach and entrance to Church
- To improve the surroundings and make the area safe
- To provide an outdoor facility to be used by a variety of groups, including our school children

Unfortunately, as a school, we are very limited to the amount of 'green space' we can access to promote learning in the outdoors. This garden will provide us with the valuable space we need to extend our learning from the classroom and develop our spiritual and reflective practice. We believe this will also provide us with yet another strong link between the school and Church. What's more, the garden will be open to the local community, thus strengthening relationships within the wider Skircoat Green community.

The cost of Phase 1 is approximately £18,000, which involves the removal and re siting of majority of the gravestones, as well as rough levelling of the landscape. Thanks to Church contributions and a couple of small grants, approximately £13,000 has been raised so far! As a school and Church community, we would like to support the project further by raising funds at strategic points across the year.

I would like to thank the parents who have contacted school regarding an issue that occurred during a recent Cross Country event. This notice is to provide the whole school community with information regarding key learning taken from this and strategies/procedures put in place to ensure the system is tight and effective when pupils leave the school site. This has been discussed and agreed with members of staff so that there's a consistent approach.

- **Stage 1:** Permission to be sought from a member of the Senior Leadership Team for all off-site activities.
- **Stage 2:** Parental consent forms are sent and returned to school.
- **Stage 3:** All trips, no matter how small, will be logged using the platform 'Evolve'. Here, risk assessments, class information (GDPR compliant), activities planned and staffing information are all recorded. This has to be approved by the Educational Visits Coordinator or the Headteacher. Some activities, depending on where they are and what is involved, also need further approval from the Local Authority. Stage 3 must be completed at least 2 weeks before the event takes place.
- **Stage 4:** In our weekly 'teacher briefing', upcoming trips and events are shared, including timings, staffing and transport details, to ensure key staff, including members of the Leadership Team, are aware.
- Stage 5: An evaluation of the trip is completed and shared, when back in school, on the 'Evolve' platform.
