

Pupil Absence during Covid-19

A Reference Guide for Parents

Key symptoms of COVID-19;

Fever (temperature of 37.8 or higher) and/or new, continuous cough (coughing for more than 1 hour of 3 coughing episodes within 24 hours) and/or loss or change in normal sense of smell or taste

What to do if	Action required	Return to school when
My child has one or more of the Covid-19 symptoms	 Do not come to school Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Book a test. Inform school immediately about the test result once received. 	 Negative test result received.
My child tests positive for Covid-19	 Do not come to school. Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Agree an earliest date for return. This will be a minimum of 10 days from the onset of symptoms. Self-isolate the entire household for 14 days from onset of symptoms. 	 The child may return after 10 days if they feel well enough. Symptoms can last for weeks however child may return even if a cough/loss of taste/smell persists.

My child tests negative and nobody else in the household has symptoms.	 Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Agree when child can return 	 Negative test result received.
My child tests negative but is still presenting with Covid-19 symptoms	 Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Contact 119 or 111 to get all clear 	 If the NHS have given all clear.
My child is ill with non Covid- 19 related symptoms	 Contact school via phone/email to inform us as per normal absence procedures. 	 When child feels well enough. For instances of sickness/diarrhea, child may return 48 hours following the last bout.
Someone in my household is displaying Covid-19 symptoms	 Do not come to school Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Self-isolate whole household. Book test for the household member displaying symptoms. Inform school immediately about the test result once received. 	 Negative test result received.
Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19.	 Do not come to school Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Isolate entire household. Agree an earliest date for return (minimum o 14 days from when the infected member became symptomatic) 	 The child has completed 14 days isolation and remains symptom free.
Someone in my household tests negative for Covid-19 but is still displaying symptoms.	 Contact school via phone/email to inform us. Contact 119 or 111 to get all clear 	 If the NHS have given all clear.
NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of someone with confirmed Covid-19.	 Do not come to school. Contact school via phone/email to inform us. 	 The child has completed 14 days isolation and remains symptom free.

We/my child has travelled and must self-isolate as a period of quarantine.	 Agree an earliest date for return. Minimum 14 days. Please do consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel. Agree an earliest date for return. Minimum 14 days. Household to isolate. 	• The quarantine period has been completed and your child remains symptom free.
We have received medical advice that my child must shield	 Do not come to school. Contact school via phone/email to inform us. 	 On NHS advice
My child's bubble is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak	 Do not come to school. If your child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 they do not need to be tested unless they develop symptoms. Your child must isolate for a period of 14 days even if they do not develop symptoms. Other members of the household do not need to self-isolate unless your child begins to develop symptoms. 	 School will inform you when the bubble will be reopened.
